Large club area - year of construction is not limited - special ticket offers

The “Hockenheim Historic – In Memory of Jim Clark“ from April 16th till 18th 2010 is the sixth event which is taking place in honour of the double world champion Jim Clark who was killed in an accident on 7th April 1968 at the Hockenheimring.

Again, fans of historical motor sports may look forward to experiencing some exciting races, a large club area, a varied social programme as well as many other highlights on and next to the track.

Motoring organisations, communities of interest, regulars' tables of veteran cars as well as friends of classic cars and today's sports cars are welcome to the large club area. The “Hockenheim Historic – In Memory of Jim Clark“ will be the meeting place for all car fans and automobiles.

The club area will be positioned at the Mercedes tribune again. Moreover, it will be allowed to enter the paddock. During the event all collector's vehicles, which park there, will get the opportunity to drive laps on the Grand-Prix track under a special guidance. Thus, the drivers can experience the track sections such as the Sachs curve by themselves.

The popular rallye “Tourist on Tour“ will start on Saturday at 1 pm. All participants are receiving a professional roadbook which describes the 80-kilometres routeing in detail. It is possible to apply for this three-hour drive on the spot.

Furthermore, members of registered enthusiasts clubs will get particular facilities (even without an application for the club area). In the case of a centralised buying, for each bought ticket the Hockenheim-Ring GmbH will throw a voucher for a further ticket in.
